1A Johnathan - great time allocation in the 1AR. I like that you got through as quick as you did so you could spend more time on the CP. On the DA, try going for more of your offense args instead of spending so much effort on the NU.

1NR - Good job extending you CP solvency, but make sure you are responding to 2AC args. The Net Benefit could use a little more impact analysis to set it apart from the plan impacts.

2AC - Diversity of arguments on the DA was great, but try to get that level of diversity on your counterplan answers.

2NC - Don't take so much in the 2AC - split the block. Your DA extension was excellent but if you had more time you could have done impact analysis.

2AR - How you relate everything back to case and impact analysis was good. Same comment to you as the 1AR, try to go for more offense on the DA.

2NR - Good job closing 2AR doors. Good explanation of offense and answering aff answers.
